


































































## -Words

#### SOME MUSIC WOT I WAS LISTENING TO WHILE MAKING THIS SHITE

(Should have done this since the end of Feels Like Falling, but, oh well)

- My God is The Sun Queens of the Stone Age (This song really goes well with chaos and is one of the overall themes of the story, usually to signal shit hitting the fan)
- Era Vulgaris Queens of the Stone Age (Mr Love's theme. Don't know who Mr. Love is? I'll give you a hint, He is a prominent character in this very issue)
- The Sky is Fallin Queens of the Stone Age (I could populate this list with nothing but Qotsa but space is limited.

  This is another overall theme that captures the series as a whole)
- Pageant of the Bizarre Zero7 (Overall theme of Life interrupted. The energy of this song is amazing and captures the complex multi-layered feel of Penelope's struggle to 'life')
- As it is in Heaven Angelspit (This is what I was listening to when I was writing Cutter's first encounter with Iverna Deskerna. It's dark, oppressive and full of style)
- Say You Love me Darling Violeta (This is the song I used to inspire the scene in issue 14 where Zencii performs.

  I eventually wrote my own song for that scene but it's goal was to totally capture the feel of this song)
- Hidden Place Bjork (Who doesn't love some Bjork to tease out that feeling of being in a trance? This is one of my very favourites)
- Amphibian Bjork (Funny enough the main reason I use this song is because it was played during the end credits of 'Being John Malkovich, one of my favourite movies. The emotions it embodies are so powerful that I can easily apply them to inspire my own writing)
- Change Deftones (A pretty general song with no specific reference in the series but overall mood)
- I am Eve Mediaeval Baebes (Here's another group whose entire Discography could be on here. For those who seem to think all my inspiration comes from darkness. Anyway this is my go-to band to inspire magical whimsy and anything faerie)
- Sleeping beauty Miranda Sex Garden (The last statement for Mediaeval Baebes applies to this band pretty much, except this band is darker and actually the precursor to MB. I just really, REALLY dig Katherine Blake)
- Sunspots Nine Inch Nails (Yet another band whose entire discography belongs on here)
- This City Tekkon Kinkreet soundtrack (I use this song for two specific characters, Adrien and Nila Nyx as they travel swiftly through their respective worlds. This song has such a wonderful feeling of air and motion. Heck just look how it's used in the opening to Tekkon Kinkreet. It's perfect)
- Spill Stolen Babies (This song perfectly captures Squid girl's nature. Go listen to it)
- Lights out Mindless Self Indulgence (This is another one that goes along perfectly with Squiddy)
- 3 Libras A perfect Circle (The buildup and payoff of this song is a thing of beauty)
- 15 step Radiohead (This is THE theme of Jackal's experiences in Feels Like Falling)
- Paranoid Android Radiohead (Jackal's theme, Radiohead on a whole just operates on the same wavelength as Diskordia)
- Black Swan Thom Yorke (Another song made more powerful by its placement in the end credits. In this case A Scanner Darkly. This song has such a great overal melancholy feel)
- Where is my Mind The Pixies (Fight Club is one of my all-time favourite movies and this song, played during the end credits perfectly captures the nihilistic insanity of that film. Figures that it goes quite well with Diskordia's unique brand of insanity as well
- The Big Push Rabbit Junk (Just listen to it! This is one of the most obscure bands I listen to but these guys get it)
- Quiet Earth Thumper Monkey (Another obscure one. These prog rockers are amazing at getting my brain to do wonderful thingst
